SOAR is an innovative program that makes it easy for parents to play an active role in their children's education. SOAR is designed for military families, and is easily accessible worldwide.

Students take an assessment aligned to state standards, and SOAR directs them to individualized tutorials to improve skills where needed. Parents can monitor their children's progress from anywhere, and are provided with resource materials.

Who is eligible to use SOAR?

SOAR was designed for all military families worldwide **and classmates of military dependents** in schools serving military installations. Coast Guard, Reserve, and National Guard families are also eligible.

What grade levels does SOAR target?

SOAR content is most appropriate for students in grades 3-11. There is limited material available for 2nd grade students. Younger students may need adult assistance to navigate the program.
